

- Logical arrangement of categories

- For example:
 - Very difficult questions
 - Category 1



- Most of the time only several types of questions are used







Multiple choice - question testing








Create questions

- Clicking on the "question mark" near the question type








Create exams

- From "Action menu" select "Turn editing on"
- Click "Add an activity or resource" and select Quiz



The quiz activity enables a teacher to create quizzes comprising questions of various types, including multiple choice, matching, shortanswer and numerical.

The teacher can allow the quiz to be attempted multiple times, with the questions shuffled or randomly selected from the question bank. A time limit may be set.

Each attempt is marked automatically, with the exception of essay questions, and the grade is recorded in the gradebook.

The teacher can choose when and if hints, feedback and correct answers are shown to students.

Quizzes may be used

- As course exams
- As mini tests for reading assignments or at the end of a topic
- As exam practice using questions from past exams
- To deliver immediate feedback about performance
- · For self-assessment


